Foreword

New Wine Ministries Hong Kong continues its vision and mission in loving and caring for those who are poverty-stricken, rejected by society and those who are sick; in particular those who suffer from cancer.

These past 18 months, under the shadow of Covid, have been particularly challenging as we strive to continue to provide emotional and spiritual support through our fellowships and healing programs based on Christian faith where our beneficiaries can find peace and rest amidst this turmoil whether they are sick or suffering poverty and neglect.

Statement

This year, we celebrate ten years of New Wine Ministries Hong Kong. Founded by Reverend Noreen Siu-Richards and incorporated in September 2011, New Wine Ministries became a non profit, non governmental organization in February 2014 and a member of the Hong Kong council of social services in 2015.

We started our Ministries at our premises in Wong Chuk Hang in 2011. Initially, we received about 20 to 30 asylum seekers every week who came for hymns and worship, preaching, talks and a hot meal. In 2017 our premises expanded to accommodate 70 persons weekly with a well equipped kitchen and canteen for asylum seekers to eat after the program. We thank FoodLink Foundation who have been our partner since 2015. In 2017 we started a 'Givings Day' to donate items such as clothing, basic necessities and food items to help them with their daily living as they only receive a small amount from the authorities. They are strictly forbidden to take up employment during their stay in Hong Kong.

In fulfilling our mission, the center has also been providing support for people who suffer from cancer as well as other chronic conditions like depression and diabetes. After completing our deep-level healing course, most have given positive testimonies. Beside our in-house healing courses, we have helped many others by reaching out to various cancer centers in Hong Kong.

With the restrictions imposed on us all by the Covid outbreak, we have had to adapt our interface with those who we seek to help. Our 'Givings Day', previously

a social event with large groups of people, has had to be carefully managed with the distribution of parcels of food and provisions arranged by individual appointment over a number of days. Even more challenging has been the increase in those seeking support with the numbers now up to 150 with many more on our waiting list. For those looking for spiritual support, we conduct services and counseling through online platforms. To facilitate this, we have a well equipped IT setup and team of technicians on hand during broadcast. The sessions are interactive with the sharing of experiences and questions raised and discussed.

As always with our fund-raising, we hope to further expand our services and welcome more people who come to us for help. We need to be able to hire, train and equip more leaders, facilitators and professionals in the field.

Last year, we were unable to hold this fund-raising event with the limits imposed by the pandemic and yet the demands on our resources increased. This event, Sing for Joy, is our main lifeline of funding for those who come to us for help. We therefore ask you to be particularly generous this year so that we can provide better support to the ever growing numbers of sick, unfortunate and neglected within our community.

He received a Fellowship from the Royal College of Surgeons of Edinburgh, the United Kingdom in 1986 and was awarded a degree of Master of Health Administration from The University of New South Wales, Australia in 1993. He became a Fellow of the Hong Kong Academy of Medicine in the specialty of Orthopaedic Surgery and Community Medicine in Administrative Medicine in 1993 and 2000, respectively. In 2002, he became a Fellow of the Faculty of Public Health Medicine of the Royal Colleges of Physicians of the United Kingdom.

Dr. Ko was the Secretary for Food and Health of the Government of Hong Kong Special Administrative Region from July 2012 to June 2017. He is a member of the 13th National Committee of the Chinese People's Political Consultative Conference. He was appointed as Justice of the Peace in 2001 and was awarded the Bronze Bauhinia Star and Gold Bauhinia Star by the Government of Hong Kong in 2008 and 2017, respectively.

Good Evening! Our honourable guests, supporters and sponsors! It gives me great pleasure to welcome you to our 10th anniversary of New Wine Ministries Hong Kong this evening. New Wine Ministries was incorporated in September 2011 and we started our mission simultaneously in the same month. We have held out our vision and mission during the past 10 years in helping the disenfranchised and impoverished asylum seekers in Hong Kong, giving them support and hope; financially and emotionally. They literally live as unknowns and the dejected people. They are legally not permitted to work and they receive very little money from the authorities, therefore they need help from the benevolent people in the society.

We used to receive a group of asylum seekers every week. We give them classes and we preach and teach them, give them hot meals which to them is a blessing as they usually live in a 6'x 10' cubicle where cooking is impossible. Most importantly, we give out cash money to them every month to subsidize their rent, electricity and other expenses to meet their daily living. Unfortunately the group meetings were brought to a halt at the beginning of 2020 where COVID-19 have hit the world globally. Amidst the worldwide turmoil, we have continuously and relentlessly assist them by receiving them one by one every 1-2 months to give them monthly financial support as well as to give them food supplies and daily necessities.

In fact since COVID-19, our group has expanded more than 50% and now we have more than 150 families including children from age 1 to 18 years whom we are supporting monthly. Our vision for 2022 will be increased to 200 families or more. We have even increased the amount of money we give them per month since January 2021. It is because there is a much greater need now than before. Additionally we maintained our closeness by zoom every 2 weeks so they feel the care and love we give them.

In regard to the cancer patients, New Wine has also zoom at our auditorium to reach out to the cancer patients in general. This technology has added more costs to the ministry. In the past ten years we have volunteered our services to the Cancer Link service centers which are the core of the Hong Kong Cancer Fund. I went into all their centers almost all year round and conduct both lectures and individual sessions to their cancer patients who had registered in our course named 'Deep-Level Healing'. A lot of these patients received released in their emotional upheaval and some was healed completely for 10 years already. All these are achieved by zoom also.

These two groups of people is benefiting from your generosity in the past as well as in the future so we hope tonight you will give so generously with a passion for compassion, our New Wine slogan. We particularly thank the Estate of the late Mok Sau King for the most generous donation in late 2019. We also thank our Philanthropist Sponsor 2020, Mrs. Purviz R. Shroff, MH this evening. Last but not least, I would like to thank Mrs. Siu Tsang Fung Kwan and Dr. Edmund K. Li, chairmen of the fundraising committee for their contribution and support as well as the entire committee team particularly Mr. Joseph Lau and Mrs. Emerald Lau. I thank all the New Wine staffs for their hard work behind the scenes. Thanking everyone present here tonight and pray the zooming will bring us all in unity together with a passion for compassion in giving!
